Magna All motorcycles start out with the same basic elements:

A frame. An engine. A pair of wheels. Brakes. A seat. And so on.

But everyone knows that all motorcycles are not equal—some just seem to do a lot more with what they've got when it comes to looks, power and overall performance.

Case in point? The awesome Honda Magna. All muscle. No fat. But with a look that'll turn heads no matter where you ride.

The Magna's a custom with a difference—a big, powerful difference. Because while most custom bikes use V-twin engines, the Magna uses one of Honda's famous V-4s. We've raced them, won world championships with them, and invented the concept of the performance custom with our 1983 V65 Magna.

A V-4 makes a perfect engine for a custom—especially this V-4. With a big-bore/short-stroke configuration, the Magna revs free and smooth, and has a horsepower curve that just goes on and on. But its compact crankshaft and 90-degree V angle let it fit right into a custom chassis and look like it belongs there. The configuration also gives the Magna massive on-tap low-end torque, just like half of a big Detroit V-8, so when you twist the throttle you know the Magna is going to deliver a different kind of power. This is not an engine that rumbles and shakes to pretend it's working. It's a throbbing waterfall of seamless power that never, ever runs dry.

The engine's four-cylinder 16-valve double-overhead-cam configuration is as cutting edge as any Superbike's, and makes other customs look apologetically weak.

Once you get past the Magna's powerful performance, you'll find that it's still an incredible bike. Its long, stretched-out, 65-inch wheelbase means it's stable at speed and comfortable to ride when the road's bumpy. The low 28-inch seat height means it's not a struggle when it's time to put your feet down at a stoplight or in a parking lot. The forward-set pegs, pullback handlebar and comfortable seat are laid-back enough for cruising comfort, but still put you in control when the road turns sporty. And because the seat is a two-piece design, if you're traveling solo you can give the Magna a unique, bold look simply by removing the passenger section.

When it comes to looks—well, that you can see for yourself. The Magna isn't a bike that tries too hard; it's secure to be what it is. Strong, yet graceful. Powerful, yet athletic and balanced in motion.

If you've ever ridden a Honda, you know there's no substitute for performance. Other bikes may make excuses, but if the whole



point of riding a custom motorcycle is to ride something a little different from what everyone else rides, and if you've ever twisted a throttle wide open just to feel that magical kick of acceleration, then Honda's awesome Magna has to be at the top of the performance-custom food chain.

What do you get when you take four carburetors, four valves per cylinder, four chain-driven overhead camshafts, a short, tough four-bearing crank, a high 10.8:1 compression ratio and high-rpm shim-under-bucket valve adjusters, add them all together and garnish with a 9750-rpm redline? Performance —Magna style.



When you're talking about the Magna's level of performance, you're talking about liquid cooling. The high-flow radiator is tucked away in front of the front cylinder bank where you'll probably never notice it—until you twist the throttle, that is.
